Mr Heng has served in various government departments, and has served as Deputy Secretary at the Ministry of Trade and Industry in 2000 and CEO of the Trade Development Board in 2001.

He was Permanent Secretary at the Ministry of Trade and Industry from November 2001 to April 2005. Mr. Heng is also a non-executive and independent Director of SingTel as well as Chairman of The Institute of Banking and Finance.

Mr Heng was conferred the Public Administration Medal (Gold) at the Singapore National Day Awards 2001.
