Mr J Y Pillay has been the Chairman of Singapore Exchange Limited since November 1999.

He graduated with a BSc (Hons), from the Imperial College of Science & Technology, University of London and joined the administrative service of the Government of Singapore in 1961, rising to the position of Permanent Secretary, in 1972. During his government service, he served in various Ministries including Finance, Defense and National Development.

Mr Pillay has also served as Managing Director of the Monetary Authority of Singapore and the Government of Singapore Investment Corporation. Other appointment he has held in the public sector includes the chairmanship of government companies like the Development Bank of Singapore, Singapore Airlines and Temasek Holdings. He was also Chairman of the Council on Corporate Disclosure and Governance from 2002 to 2007.

In addition, Mr Pillay has also served as Singapore's High Commissioner in Britain from 1996 to 1999. He was also appointed to the Council of Presidential Advisers of the Republic of Singapore in 2001, becoming its Chairman in 2005. He is also a member of the Presidential Council for Minority Rights.
