Datuk Dr S Subramaniam holds the position of Human Resource Minister in the Malaysian federal cabinet.

Before entering the politics, he worked as the Medical Officer of Tangkak General Hospital in Johor, and later in the Malacca General Hospital. In 1985, he started a private clinic, Subra Skin Clinic in Malacca.

Datuk Dr Subramaniam has held a variety of positions within the Malaysian Indian Congress (MIC) serving as the Chairman of Ujung Pasir Baru Branch MIC, committee member of Kota Melaka Division MIC and deputy chairman of Malacca MIC Liaison Body. He is also a member of the MIC Executive Council and Secretary-General of the Malaysian Indian Congress (MIC) since 2006.

Datuk Dr Subramaniam was a member of Malacca City Council from 2000 to 2003. MP for Segamat, Johor from 2004 and Parliamentary Secretary of Housing and Local Government Ministry from 2004 to March 2008.

He has been awarded the Ping Jasa Kebatktian (PJK) from the Malaccan Head of State as well as Pingat Kesatriaang Mangku Negara, (KNM) and Panglima Jasa Negara, (PJN) by the King of Malaysia.
