Mr Sundaresh Menon is a Senior Counsel and the Senior Partner of the firm Rajah & Tann. He graduated with First Class Honors from the National University of Singapore and later took a Masters degree from Harvard Law School where he again achieved academic distinction.

He was admitted to the Bar in Singapore and in the State of New York and has been practicing in the field of commercial arbitration and litigation for 20 years. During that time, he has advised and represented clients as lead counsel in complex and technical disputes throughout Asia including in Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Indonesia, the Philippines, India, Hong Kong, Brunei, Taiwan, Laos, Vietnam, Cambodia and Sri Lanka.

Mr Menon has also appeared in arbitration proceedings in various jurisdictions including London, Paris, Geneva, Singapore and Hong Kong. His experience in arbitration extends to numerous cases governed by various Rules of Arbitration including the ICC Rules, the UNCITRAL Rules, the SIAC Rules, the HKIAC Rules, and the LCIA Rules.

Mr Menon is a member of the Main Panel of Arbitrators of the SIAC and of the Panel of Arbitrators of the Beijing Arbitration Commission. He is also a Fellow of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators. He represented Singapore as a delegate at the UNCITRAL Working Group on International Arbitration from 2003 to 2005.

Mr Menon rejoined Rajah and Tann in April 2007 after completing a one year stint as Judicial Commissioner. During his term, he presided over a number of major commercial and criminal matters. He was appointed Senior Counsel in January 2008.
